EARLY SPRING	TOOLS/PRODUCTS
<input type="checkbox"/> STEP 1. GET YOUR LAWN MOWER READY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give your mower some tender, loving care – this means a tune-up and a good cleaning • Change the oil, air filter, spark plug, and sharpen the mower blade 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lawn mower oil • Air Filter & Spark Plug
<input type="checkbox"/> STEP 2. CLEAN UP <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove leaves, branches, and twigs that have appeared over winter 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rake • Garden waste bags • Garden gloves

GREEN, THICKEN & PREVENT WEEDS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply lawn food in early spring to promote strong roots and help grass green-up • If weeds were present in prior seasons, apply weed prevent in early spring to help keep weeds out of your lawn 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scott's® Turf Builder® Lawn Food • Scott's® Turf Builder® Weed Prevent • A Scott's® lawn products spreader

<input type="checkbox"/> STEP 5. REPAIR BARE SPOTS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fix bare patches with spot seeding • Water daily for at least 1 week, but ideally until the grass reaches mow-able height 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Scott's® ezseed® Patch & Repair

SEED TO THICKEN <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Healthy turf crowds out weeds, so apply a high-quality grass once average temperatures are between 15°C and 26°C and follow up with an application of lawn food for new grass • OR apply a 3-in-1 lawn repair mix that combines seed, fertilizer and a soil enhancer 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Scott's lawn products spreader • Any Scott's® Turf Builder® Grass Seed • Scott's® Turf Builder® Starter™ Lawn Food for New Grass OR • Scott's® Lawn Response 9-1-1
